Who Controls The Finances?

GLAD YOU ASKED!

Finances have always been the most abused area of development aid in Africa, and throughout many developing countries around the world.

It was stated by The Hon. James Wani Iga, Speaker of the National Assembly of the Government of Southern Sudan:

“Of the billions of dollars which disappears through corruption and fraud throughout the world, 95% of it happens in Africa.” He went on to say, “We will not put up with this in the New Sudan!” (Jan. 9,

the farms, including the management team.

It is expected that within an 18 to 30 month period, every farm begun will have reached a level of financial self-sufficiency. If this does not happen, an inquiry will be held to examine the reasons.

When a farm reaches self-sufficiency, 10% of its profit will be paid back into the Central SFC Fund for development of new farms, The remaining 90% will be rolled back into the farm from which the profit was made for development, expansion and further modernization of that individual farm.

With the Savannah Farmers Cooperative (SFC) a very unique thing is happening . We have put in place a Zero Tolerance Policy for corruption, fraud and theft. Steal once and you're gone! We are almost certain that we have cleared out all those who have been dishonest. If more fraud appears, it will be dealt with decisively.

Teaching Farm Managers

With our new management team in the SFC, we are confident that we have structure and the control of the funds,

both incoming from sales of produce, as well as from donor agencies. Every farm manager is responsible to Miss Fiona Onyinda, our Accountant and book-keeper. Fiona checks the accounts of every farm on a regular basis. If the accounts are not clear on a farm, further work funds are not released to the farm until matters are clarified.

All expenses are accounted for on every farm, including everything from seeds to fuel and wages. Tools, nails and clothes-for-work will all be accounted for. Inventories will be kept of all tools on each farm and on the Central SFC Compound.

Cal Bombay Ministries has an arrangement with the Nile Bank in Kampala, Uganda where all SFC accounts are kept. There are no banks yet developed in the area where the farms are located. The Manager of the branch keeps Cal Bombay Ministries up-dated by email about all deposits and withdrawals.

The Managing Director, The Hon. Zamba Duku, sends periodic consolidated reports to Cal Bombay Ministries of all funds dispersed to the various farms and funds received by each farm for the rental use of our tractors and drivers, as well as for sale and distribution of product. Every base is being covered.

The General Manger, Mr. Abusa Edward, oversees the sales and distribution of all crops. Miss Fiona Onyinda checks every invoice and receipt on each of the farms to assure accuracy and the inclusion of every transaction. None of the farm managers spends any funds for an unusual purchase or expense without the consent and full knowledge of the General Manager.

Cal Bombay, or his Administrative Assistant, (when he gets one) goes to Sudan at least twice a year to do a visual inspection of the farms, the books and the produce, and to interview various employees of
